This update includes the following errors related to Auto Part Credit Long-Term Solution:
 - **F866: AUTO LICENSE PRESENT – DUTY NOT ALLOWED** An Automobile License for Importer's Additional Declaration Record Type '11' is submitted on a line, yet duty is present on the corresponding auto part ch.99 HTS number.
 - **F861: AUTO LICENSE INSUFFICIENT BALANCE** The submitted Automobile License for Importer's Additional Declaration Record Type '11' has a balance that is not sufficient to cover the submitted auto part duty.
