Flight Cancellations and Temporary Shipment Embargo at Shanghai Airport

On August 20, two workers associated with Shanghai-Pudong International Airport Cargo Terminal, Ltd. (PACTL) were suspected of Covid-19 infection. As a result, most airport staff were required to undergo same-day on-site Covid-19 PCR testing. A significant number of airlines have placed a temporary embargo on cargo bookings and have cancelled inbound and outbound flights through the weekend.

The implementation of new air terminal staff regulations has been expedited, and is expected to impact operations and flight frequencies.

Qingdao's Airport Authority has also issued a notice that import operations will resume at Qingdao Liuting International Airport (TAO) on August 21, 2020 with the following known restrictions:

- No temperature-controlled shipments
- No bulk-load shipments
