

Transportation Operations to be Impacted by Nationwide Strike in Belgium

A nationwide general strike is scheduled to take place across Belgium on Monday, March 31st, 2025, beginning at 00:00 and ending at 23:59 local time.

Brussels Airport (BRU) has <u>canceled all outbound flights</u>, and inbound flights may also experience delays and cancellations due to the participation of ground handling and security personnel. Cargo operations at BRU will be severely limited, with only life-saving cargo permitted for transport during the strike period.

Broader transport disruptions are also expected, including rail freight and port operations. Five railway unions and maritime workers <u>have confirmed</u> their participation Monday's strike. Some vessels <u>have already been diverted</u> to neighboring ports, and additional delays are likely.
