



Port of Montreal Lockout- Operational and Logistics Impacts

On November 10th, 2024, the Port of Montreal's Termont terminals (Viau and Maisonneuve) entered a lockout after the longshoremen's union, CUPE Local 375, rejected the Maritime Employers Association (MEA) final wage offer. This lockout has caused significant logistical disruptions, as Canadian National Railway (CN) and Canadian Pacific Kansas City (CPKC) have temporarily halted rail shipments to these terminals. Shipping carriers are investigating cargo diversions as the lockout prolongs.

• **Rail Restrictions:** Canadian National Railway and Canadian Pacific Kansas City have suspended services to Montreal-bound intermodal terminals.

• **Alternative Ports for Cargo:** Halifax and Saint John are seeing increased cargo volume to reduce delays.
