

[January 14 Presidential Action: Proclamation “Adjusting Imports of Semiconductors, Semiconductor Manufacturing Equipment, and Their Derivative Products into the United States.”](#)

A [Presidential Proclamation](#) has been issued pursuant to Section 232 of the 1962 Trade Expansion Act, as amended (19 U.S.C. 1862), imposing 25% ad valorem duties on certain imports of semiconductors and their derivative products under a two-phase plan of action.

Under the first phase, a 25% ad valorem tariff will be imposed on certain defined “semiconductor articles” **classified under Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (HTSUS) subheadings 8471.50, 8471.80, and 8473.30**, from **any country of origin**. The tariff applies to goods entered into the U.S. or withdrawn from warehouse starting **12:01 a.m. ET on January 15, 2026**, as described in the [Proclamation](#) and its [Annex](#). Per the proclamation, this tariff will remain in effect unless expressly reduced, modified, or terminated by subsequent action.

U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) has posted [CSMS # 67400472 - GUIDANCE: Section 232 Import Duties on Semiconductors and their Derivative Products](#), in connection with the above action. A [Fact Sheet](#) has also been issued by the White House in connection with the above action.
