

A nationwide strike has been announced in France for Thursday, September 18, 2025. According to internal KWE sources, significant nationwide disruptions to air and sea freight operations should be anticipated.

Air Operations

- Flight delays and cancellations are likely at major airports, including Paris Charles de Gaulle (CDG), Orly (ORY), and Lyon (LYS).
- Limited capacity on flights that do operate.
- Ground handling, customs clearance, and delivery operations may be slowed.

Sea Operations

- Reduced activity is expected in ports such as Le Havre, Marseille, and Fos-sur-Mer.
- Possible access blockages and slower port handling.

Other Transport Disruptions

- Widespread participation is expected across rail and public transport networks, including Paris metro, tram, and bus services.
- Road traffic may be impacted by demonstrations and possible blockades, including actions by taxi drivers.
- Strikes may also affect flights crossing French airspace, with knock-on effects across Europe.
