- The [U.S. Department of the Interior](#), through the U.S. Geological Survey, published the final [2025 List of Critical Minerals](#), outlining 60 minerals vital to the U.S. economy and national security that face potential risks from disrupted supply chains. The list shows ten more critical minerals could be subject to [Section 232 tariffs](#): boron, copper, lead, metallurgical coal, phosphate, potash, rhenium, silicon, silver, uranium -based on new data, public feedback and interagency recommendations. The 2025 List marks the third List since the effort began under a [2017 Executive Order \(EO 13817\)](#) directing federal agencies to strengthen mineral security.
- [CPSC's Product Registry Training Videos](#) - The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) Product Registry is a secure online application where importers can store and manage their product certificate data to transmit [Reference PGA Message Sets](#) to [U.S. Customs and Border Protection \(CBP\)](#)'s ACE system at the time of entry. The registry serves as a stand-alone central data repository and does not communicate with CBP's ACE system. Self-registration is currently open and accepting new participants and the Registry will close once the **2,000-participant limit** is reached, in accordance with the limitations outlined in the [Federal Register Notice](#).
- [U.S. President Trump Solidifies Economic & Defense Partnership with Kingdom of Saudi Arabia](#) – securing investment commitment to almost \$1 trillion
- The U.S. [Environmental Protection Agency](#) issued a [proposed rule](#) for amendments to the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) regulation for reporting and recordkeeping requirements for perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS). Comments due by December 29, 2025.
